JANUARY 11, 2016

Doug Barton called the meeting to order.

Kathy Webb announced there would be a City meeting on the Metroplan regarding I-30 issues. The meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 12, 2016 .

Robert Walker reported on the Coalition of Greater Little Rock meeting Saturday, Jan. 9th. The meeting was regarding the apartment issues involving Jason Bolden and the City of Little Rock.

There was an update to the Rose Creek Trail Project given by the Director of Parks and Rec, Truman Tolefree. Mark Webre, the Deputy Director, reported they had gotten some funds to start the trail. He also provided maps showing the properties needing to be acquired in order to continue the trail to tie into the citywide/countywide trail that will eventually go all the way to Hot Springs.

The next step they will take is to call the owners of these properties to see if the property can be acquired. Mark Webre has been doing the due diligence and title search on properties owned by Jared Woodley. Timeline for getting land and to see the completion of the trail as presented at this meeting is about 5 – 10 years.

Robert Walker presented a proposal to present to the Highway Dept. and other government officials regarding noise abatement on 630.

The vote on the Phoenix House has been postponed. There will be updates when available.
