**Welcome and Approve Minutes**

**Guest Speakers**

Cara Chapman introduced Heather Smith – independent distributor for Shaklee. Heather explained that the Shaklee company was “cause marketing.” The money from products purchased goes to charities.

Shaklee offers products in harmony with nature and offers clean starter kits. The product uses all natural materials and offers less waste and less packaging because the original bottles can be refilled.

CVSSNA can enroll in the program and offer the products through a link with Shaklee.

City Director Stacy Hurst addressed the members about the proposed tax increase going to the polls in September. Hurst wanted the opinions of the members about the increase. Hurst said that budgeting for 2012 would be brutal if something was not done to make capitol improvements.
