August 13, 2007

Minutes

Kathleen called the meeting to order:

1) Brian Minyard, from the City Planning Department gave a report on the voting for the local historic district ordinance. As of August 13, approximately 130 votes have been returned. Of those, roughly 60% have been in favor of the proposed ordinance and roughly 40% have been against it.

2) Little Rock Director Joan Adcock spoke on a few issues. First, she reported that she was going to introduce a resolution to have the county judge take prisoners that the city is not able to detain. She is concerned with the fact that home burglaries are skyrocketing. The Arkansas Constitution allows for counties to take in prisoners that cities are not able to accommodate.

Director Adcock also urged people to vote on the proposals being considered during the special mayoral election.

Finally, she talked about Little Rock's Land Bank program in response to questions, especially about the lot at 7th and Coates, from some of the residents.

3) Robert reported about the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. Our neighborhood no longer qualifies for the funding because it now exceeds the income requirements.

4) Evelyn gave a report on the finances. As of May 31, 2007, the balance was \$2,381.53. By August 13, 2007, the balance was \$1,931.19. Income totaled \$45 in membership dues and expenditures totaled \$495.34 for postage for the mailing for the historic district ordinance.
